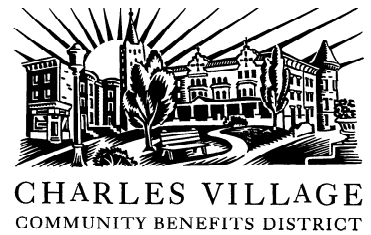

History

Boardered by 20th Street, 27th Street, Howard Street and Guilford Avenue, Old Goucher is a community with a diverse mix of residents, non-profit organizations, professional businesses and retail shops.

The name, Old Goucher, refers to the historic buildings that once housed the Goucher College Campus in the late 1800's and early 1900's. Reverend John F. Goucher founded the Woman's College of Baltimore in 1885 as a continuation of the centennial celebration of the Lovely Lane United Methodist Church. The school moved to its current location in Towson in the 1940's, but has since made an effort to re-establish itself in the Baltimore City community. Twenty-two of the original Goucher buildings still stand today.

Old Goucher is known for its variety of ethnic restaurants and shops and its Victorian architecture. The neighborhood has one park, two playgrounds, one library, 6 schools, 14 churches, 2,500 residents and over 400 businesses.

Economic Revitalization

Consulting services for businesses are available at the CVCBD at no charge. The Economic Development & Housing Director also helps connect businesses to the resources available to them, such as façade grants, loans, and available office & retail space. Sanitation

Trash pick-up days are Wednesday and Saturday in Old Goucher. Put your garbage out after 6 p.m. the night before pick-up or before 6:30 a.m. on the day of pick-up. Trash must be securely bagged, and placed in a trash can with a lid. The CVCBD Clean Team supplements Baltimore City Trash Services by sweeping sidewalks, curbs, gutters & alleys, and by removing illegally dumped trash. The Clean Team cleans Old Goucher on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

To report crime anonymously, businesses may request a Crime Watch number from the Baltimore City Police Department. The number is a confidential identification number that you give to the 9-1-1 operator after dialing "9-1-1" to report crimes you have witnessed.
